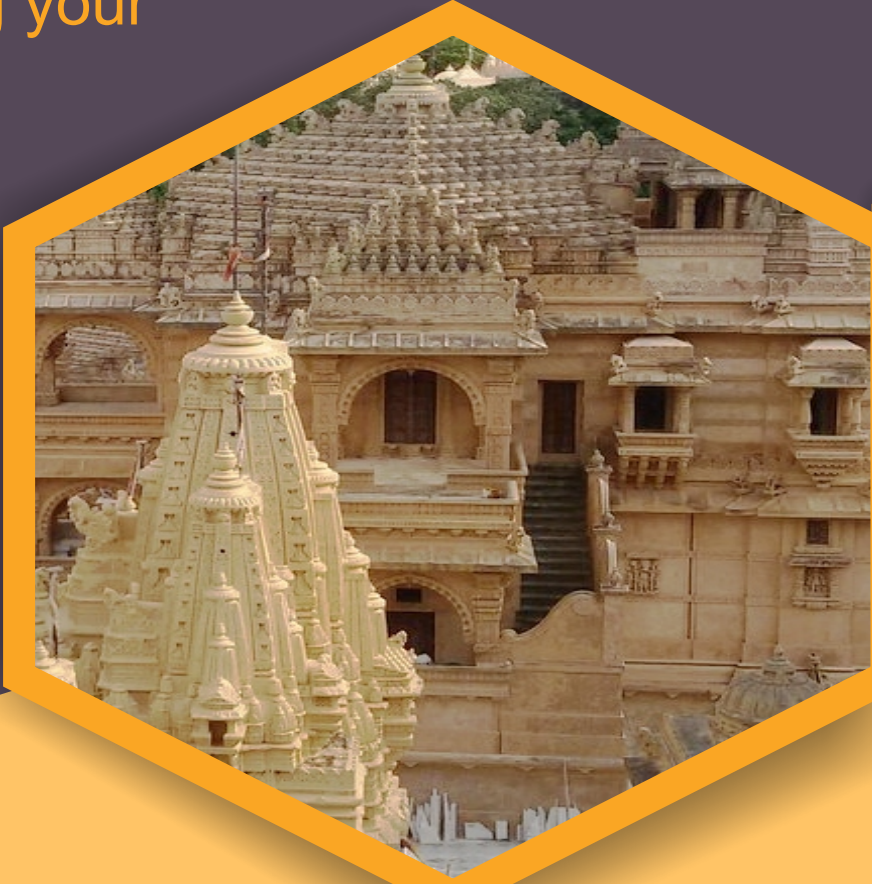

About the Program: This program is an abridged version of the summer program by ISJS. Since 2018, more than 40 participants from India, USA, Italy, Ethiopia, Zimbabwe, Ukraine, Czech Republic, China and Singapore have attended this 10-day winter program. This year due to COVID-19 and international travel restrictions this program will be online for overseas participants.

Who is Eligible? This program is designed for Undergraduate students, graduate students, degree holders, PhD Candidates, Professors and faculties in Religion, Philosophy, South Asian Studies and Anthropology and other related subjects (history, art, music, public health, bio-ethics, education, management, etc.) and educated Jains who wish to know about their religion.

Highlights of the program: Online lecture by subject experts / scholars; Interaction with Jain saints and householder family; View online Pujas; Group discussions. Participants will have an opportunity to visit Jain pilgrim places and saints in India for 2-3 days during summer 2021 with its summer school participants. ONLY travel 'to and from their home-India-home' will be borne by participants.
