- Introductory lectures (basics of Prakrit language)
- > Prakrit grammar based on Siddha-hema-shabdanushasan by Acharya Hemachandra
- > Translation and grammatical analysis of selected texts of different Prakrit dialects
- > Practice of spoken Prakrit and passage writing
- > Study manuscripts and epigraphs, convert them to Devanagari, and translate into English
